Our Mission

Vet Centers serve combat veterans and their families by providing continuum of quality care that adds value for the veterans, families and communities.

Care includes professional readjustment counseling, community education outreach to special populations, brokering of services with community agencies, and provides a key access link between the veteran and other services in the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs.

We are the people in the VA who welcome home war veterans with honor by providing quality readjustment services in a caring manner, assisting veterans and their family members toward a successful post-war adjustment in or near their communities.

Eligibility

Veterans are eligible if they served on active duty in a combat theater during ***World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, the Gulf War, or the campaigns in Lebanon, Grenada, Panama, Somalia, Bosnia, Kosovo, Afghanistan, Iraq, the Global War on Terror or Operation New Dawn (OND).***

Veterans, who served in the active military during the Vietnam-era, but not in the Republic of Vietnam, must have requested services at a Vet Center before Jan. 1, 2004. Vet Centers do not require enrollment in the VHA Health Care System.
